SERVICES:

- 248 individuals with disabilities received services to help them enjoy meaningful, productive lives and participate in their communities
- 605 individuals received in-home healthcare, hospice and personal care services in 2021
- 175 low-income seniors gained job skills to enable them to re-enter the workforce
- 454 individuals with disabilities or disadvantages gained work experience and job training in Montana Goodwill stores during 2021

Our Adult Day Services offer social and recreational activities in a safe environment for seniors and individuals with disabilities who are unable to stay home alone safely. The program fills a critical need for working Montanans who are caring for an aging spouse or parent.
